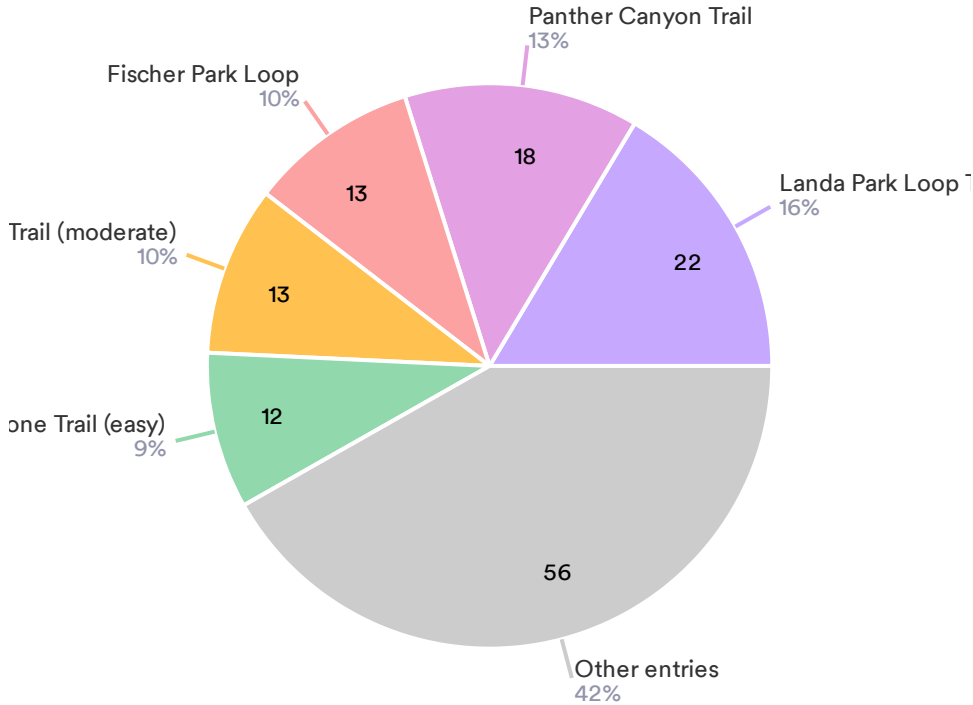

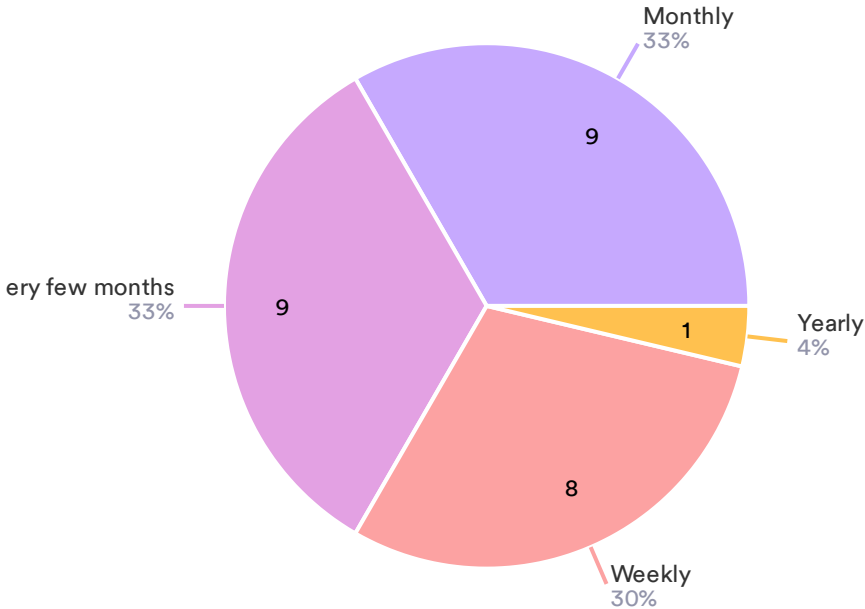
Which trails have you visited? Check all that apply.

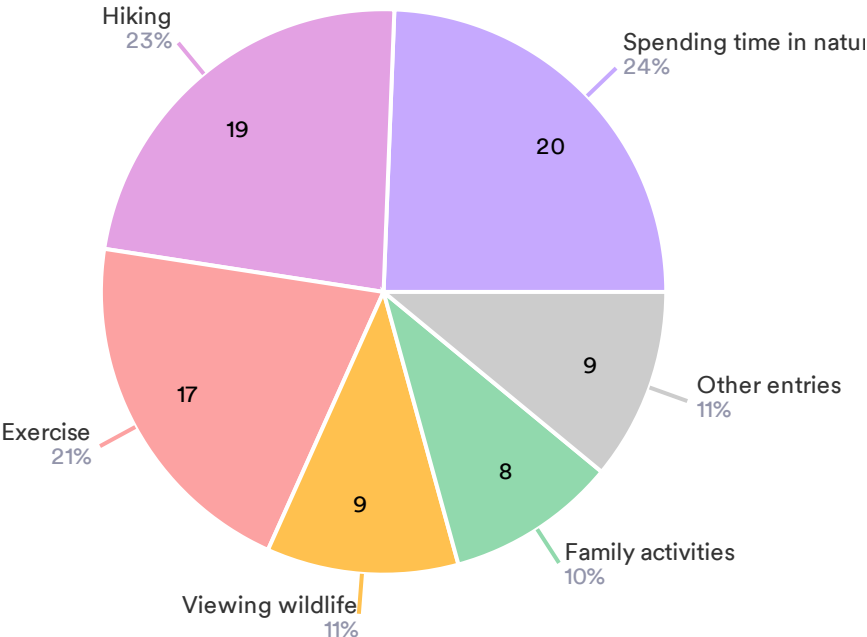

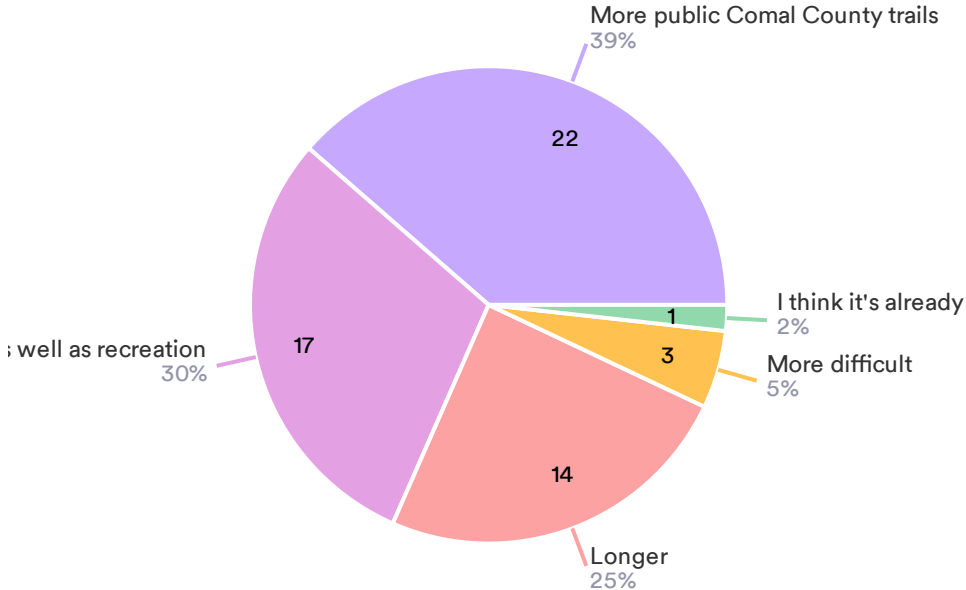

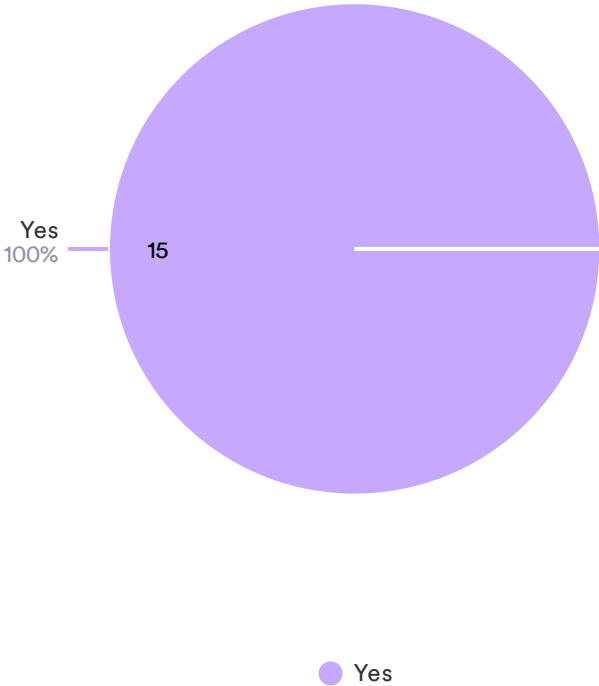

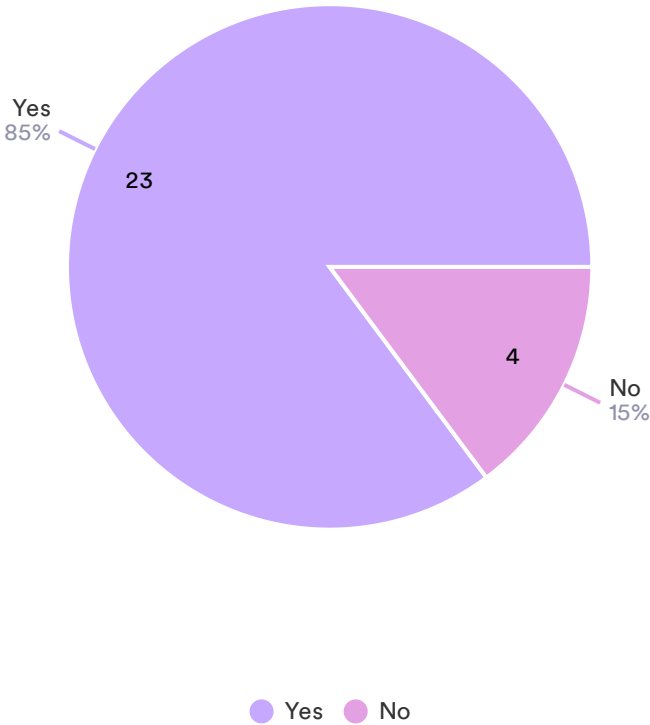
